

 - Mission 3 (June) Final presentation, 1st Prize: \$20,000 seed money


KEPP: KAIST Entrepreneurial Partnership Program

- Science & Tech Startup Seed Investment from KAIST Holdings or associated VCs



 - Holding on/off-line parallelly


